INVITATION FOR BIDS

Issuance Date: 22 July 2021

Deadline for Submission of Bids: 09 September 2021, 10:00 (local time)

1. The Kingdom of Cambodia has received financing from the Asian Development Bank (ADB) towards the cost of Fourth Greater Mekong Subregion Corridor Towns Development Project. A portion of this financing will be applied for eligible payments under the Contract named above. The Bidding is open to Bidders from eligible source countries of the ADB. The eligibility rules and procedures of ADB will govern the bidding process.
2. The Ministry of Public Works and Transport (MPWT) (“the Employer”) hereby invites sealed bids from eligible Bidders for the construction and completion of the following contract package.

3. The Works include:

- a) Sewage collection network primary, secondary and tertiary sewer pipes, manholes and house service connections pipework.
- b) Sewage Network Pump Stations to collect sewage flows from the sewer network and then to the WWTP
- c) WWTP of 5,000 m³/d capacity, the land has been used for about 2.15 ha for the main WWTP area (filled in area), about 3.75 ha for the wetland zone 1 and 2 and 1 ha for the drainage corridor around the wetland zone 1-2. The remaining about 4.5 ha of the total WWTP area is used for the natural wetland zone 3, which is also functioning as a natural retention reservoir.
- d) Storm Drainage system includes primary RCU drains, box drains, trapezoidal drain, pipes, manholes and outlet structure.
- e) Drainage Pump Station to collect storm water from the catchments, WWTP treated effluent and wetland area.

4. International Competitive Bidding will be conducted in accordance with ADB’s Single Stage One-Envelope Bidding Procedure with post Qualifications and is open to all Bidders from eligible countries of ADB as specified in the Bidding Document

5. Eligible bidders must meet the following criteria:

- (i) The bidders’ net worth within last year shall be positive.
- (ii) Minimum average annual construction turnover of **US\$20.39 million** calculated as total certified payments received for contracts in progress or completed, within the last three (3) years (2018-2019 & 2020).
- (iii) The bidder must demonstrate that its financial resources defined in FIN - 3, less its financial obligations for its current contract commitments defined in FIN - 4, meet or exceed the total requirement for the Subject Contract of **US\$2.55 million**
- (iv) Participation in at least one contract that has been successfully or substantially completed within the last eight (8) years and that is similar to the proposed works, where the value of the Bidder’s participation exceeds US\$24.50 million. Contract of similar nature involving construction of

wastewater treatment plant, and Sewers/Sewerages and drainage system

- (v) For the above or other contracts executed during the period stipulated in (iv) above, a minimum construction experience in the following key activities: (a) Wastewater treatment plant, capacity at least 3,500 cu.m per day; (b) HDPE (or equivalent material) sewers (200 mm diameter or larger) at least 5km in length; (c) Storm Drainage, any material, (at least 1.0 m diameter or a cross-section of 0.785 m² for other shape), at least 1km in length.

7. To purchase the bidding documents in English eligible bidders should:

- (i) Write to address above requesting for the bidding documents for the Contract Package No. PMU/MPWT/CTDP4/ICB/CW06
- (ii) A complete set of bidding documents in English may be purchased by interested bidders on submission of a written application to H.E. Vong Pisith, Project Director, at PMU-Office, First Floor, Road 598 SK Sangkat Chraing Chamres II, Khan Russey Keo, Phnom Penh, Cambodia and upon payment of a non-refundable fee of US\$250 or its equivalent in Cambodian Riel being 1,000,000.00 Riel. The method of payment will be in cash or deposit to Bank account No.000000001333 of National Bank of Cambodia. The Bidding Documents may be collected in person, or may be sent by email or courier, at the discretion of the bidder, but the bidder has to deposit the fee at the above bank account and to pay for courier charge by his/her arrangement as appropriate. Other than payment of the non-refundable fee specified above, there shall be no other conditions for the purchase of the bidding documents.

The bidding documents can be purchased during normal working days from between 8:00 am – 11:30 am and 2:30 pm – 5:00 pm at the address under 6 above, from 22 July 2021.

8. Bidders should deliver their bids:

- (i) To the address given under item 6 above **on or before the deadline: 10:00 a.m. (local time) on 09 September 2021.**
- (ii) Together with a Bid Security in the amount as specified in the Bidding Documents. For the purpose of determining the equivalent amount of the required Bid Security in a freely convertible currency, the selling exchange rate published by the National Bank of Cambodia on the date 28 days prior to the deadline for Bid submission shall be applied.

Bids will be opened immediately after the deadline, in the presence of bidders’ representatives who choose to attend.

The bidder shall bear all costs associated with the preparation and submission of its Bids and the Employer shall not be responsible or liable for those costs, regardless of the conduct or outcome of the bidding process.
